Sodium bicarbonate

or **sodium hydrogen carbonate** is the chemical compound with the formula NaHCO_3 . Sodium bicarbonate is a white solid that is crystalline but often appears as a fine powder. It has a slight alkaline taste resembling that of washing soda (sodium carbonate). It is also produced artificially. Since it has long been known and is widely used, the salt has many related names such as **baking soda**, **bread soda**, **cooking soda**, **bicarbonate of soda**.

Sodium carbonate

(also known as **washing soda**, **soda crystals** or **soda ash**), Na_2CO_3 , is a sodium salt of carbonic acid. It is domestically well known for its everyday use as a water softener. It has a cooling alkaline taste, and can be extracted from the ashes of many plants. It is synthetically produced in large quantities from table salt in a process known as the Solvay process.


Sodium per carbonate


is a white crystalline water-soluble chemical compound of sodium carbonate and hydrogen peroxide. Sodium per carbonate is the active ingredient in many powdered oxygen eco-friendly bleach products. It is an oxidizing agent and ingredient in a number of home and laundry cleaning products.

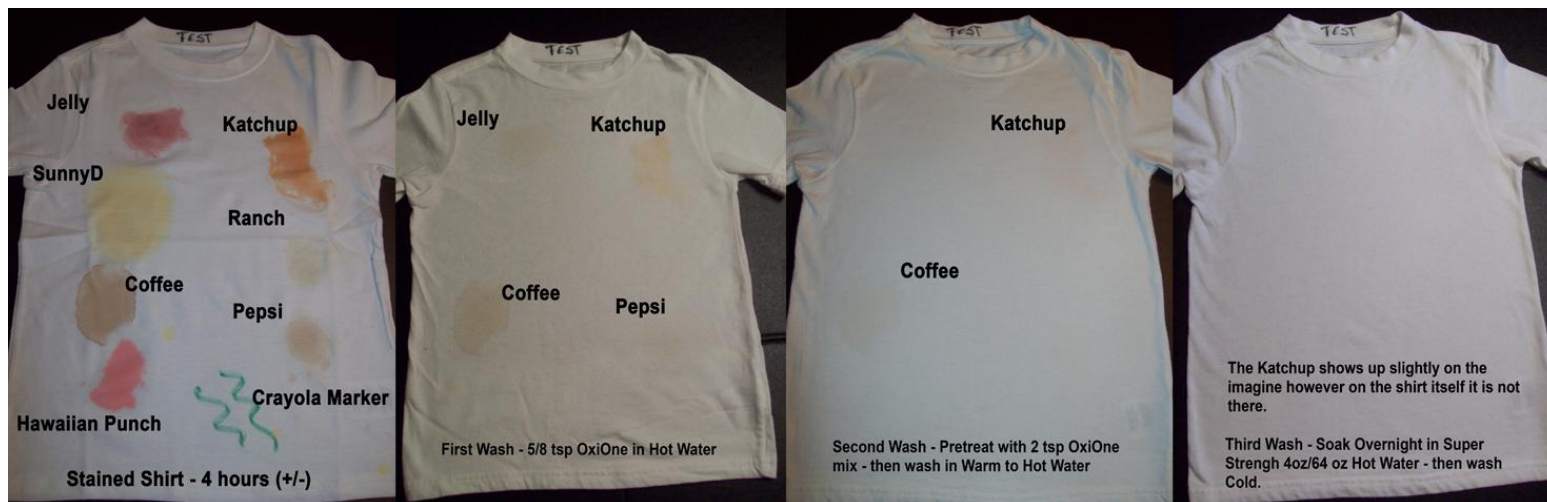

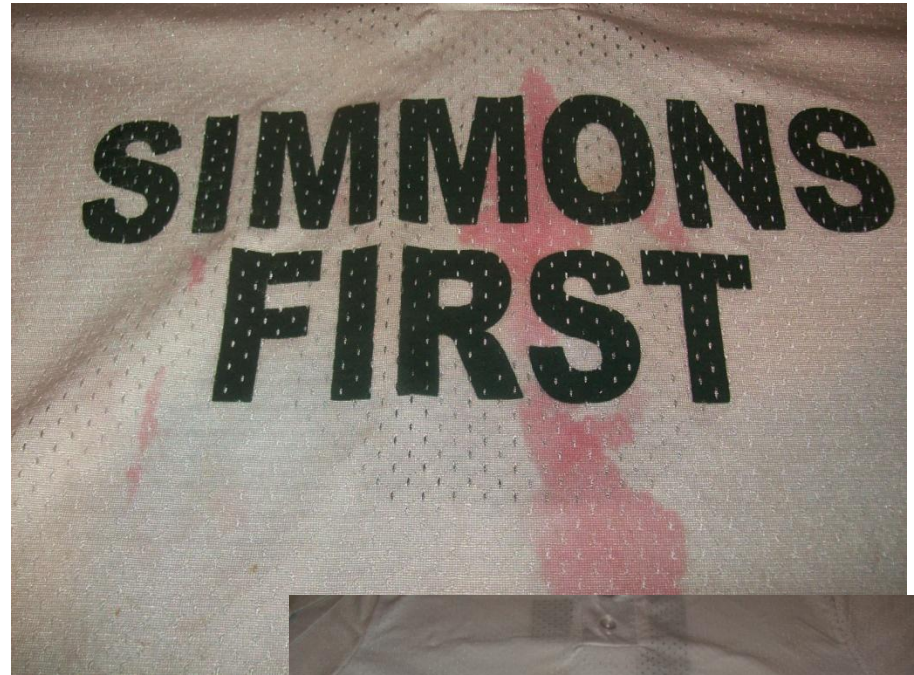

This consolidated chemical list includes chemicals subject to reporting requirements under the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA), also known as Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA)¹, and chemicals listed under section 112(r) of the Clean Air Act (CAA). This consolidated list has been prepared to help firms handling chemicals determine whether they need to submit reports under sections 302, 304, or 313 of EPCRA and, for a specific chemical, what reports may need to be submitted. It will also help firms determine whether they will be subject to accident prevention regulations under CAA section 112(r). Separate lists are also provided of Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) waste streams and unlisted hazardous wastes, and of radionuclides reportable under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA).

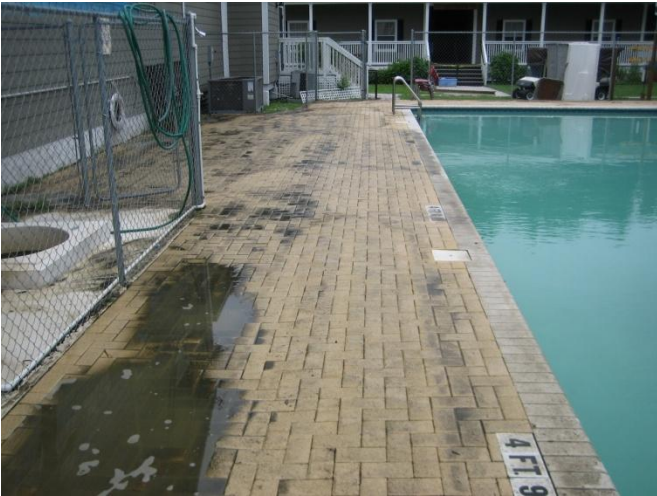
